The morning will consist of an in-depth introduction to the Bernese Mountain Dog and the Kennel Club Breed Standard by breed-specialist Stephen Green, followed by the MCE before lunch. The afternoon will split into 2 groups to allow for those requiring Hands on Assessment or Group Mentoring.

Following lunch, we have a limited number of spaces available for a Hands-on Assessment for those completing the A-list judging route.

BAD & MCE	£30	Open to those following the JEP judging route who have completed all the requirements of level 1: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Minimum of five years proven interest in pedigree dogs - Attend a requirements of a dog show judge seminar (but not mandatory to take and pass examination) - Attend a conformation and movement seminar - Complete a minimum of two full-day stewarding appointments 	
JEP BAD, MCE & Hands on Group Mentoring	£30	Following attending the BAD and passing the MCE, if all other Level 2 requirements are met then you will be welcome to join us for mentoring session in the afternoon. Open to those following the JEP judging route and completed the requirements of level 1 (as detailed above) and completed all the requirements of level 2 which are as follows and are now working towards level 3. <u>First Breed</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Take and pass requirements of a dog show judge examination - Pass points of a dog assessment - Attend a breed appreciation day (BAD) and pass a multiple-choice examination (MCE) for the respective breed - View ring stewarding seminar and take online quiz - Complete critique writing seminar and take online quiz <u>Subsequent Breed</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Attend a breed appreciation day (BAD) and pass a multiple-choice examination (MCE) for each breed. Note: Not mandatory for group judge for breeds in the group that they are not approved at level 4, but attendance strongly recommended 	
A-List BAD, MCE & Hands on Assessment (A list route)	£35	Available to those judges who are hoping to progress to the A list – please note the numbers required to progress to the A list is 70 dogs.
